

Summer programs:

J.A.M. (3 yr.-olds - those who finished K) **Mission Expedition** (finished Grades 1-5)

J.A.M. - Thursdays, beginning June 11th 11:00 - 11:30 AM

An adult must accompany child to the grass area beside the sanctuary for a short time of Mission lessons, games, etc. with Mrs. June and Alyssa. Children will be socially distanced and assigned a spot to sit. Hand sanitizer will be available. Materials will not be shared. Restroom visits will be under the supervision of the accompanying adult. Because this group must meet outside, no rain date!

Mission Expedition: Thursdays, beginning June 11th 9:30 - 11:30 AM

Parents will drop off their child for M.Ex. by driving through the breezeway. A volunteer will greet them and ask the parent if the child meets the **Well-Child Policy**. There will be a touchless temperature check for volunteers and children. The parent will assist any child exiting the car and the volunteer will direct the child or go with the child to the Fellowship Hall.

Handwashing with soap and water upon entering class, before & after hands on activities and after restroom visits. Children will enter restrooms one at the time and an adult will monitor handwashing. Sanitation wipes & sprays will be used frequently on all surfaces including doors, sinks and stalls

Children will have an assigned place at a table to maintain social distancing precautions. They will have personal supplies for crafts, games, manipulatives, etc. to avoid sharing.

At the end of the session, the volunteer teachers will bring the children to the breezeway and have them sit 6 feet apart as they wait for their parent to pick them up.

Before and after use, classrooms, tables, chairs will be sanitized.

Sanitizer will be in available in every room. Gloves will be available in each room for adults.

Games will be chosen to accommodate social distancing restrictions.

All singing will be outside in large, open areas with appropriate distancing.

Playground equipment will not be used until state guidelines allow. When allowed, playground equipment will be sanitized and maintained to state guidelines.

At the conclusion of the class/program all surfaces and materials used will be sanitized with a mist of disinfectant spray. Items used will be set aside for this sanitizing as they are used throughout the day and will not be reintroduced until sanitized.

FBC Cleaning Services will also clean each room and bathroom in addition to the cleaning done by volunteer teachers & assistant teachers.

Well-Child Policy

Children need to be fever free (without a fever reducer) for 24 hours before attending class.

Children may not attend class if they have had diarrhea or vomiting in the last 24 hours.

Children may not attend class with pink-eye- symptoms.

On a case-by-case basis, parents and volunteers need to distinguish between allergy and upper respiratory illnesses. For some children, allergy symptoms are common. Those with upper respiratory illnesses may not attend class. Train parents to follow the policy of "***When in doubt....don't come***" as they decide if a child is ill.
